## Parking & Public Transportations

### **Parking Information:**

The Library is at the corner of South Fullerton Ave. and Plymouth Sts.

Thanks to the help of the Montclair Public Library and the Montclair Parking Authority, all the attendees will be able to use the **Crescent Parking Deck** (one ½ blocks closer to Bloomfield Ave.) at a discounted rate (50%):

### **Parking Instructions:**

- 1) Park in the Crescent Deck & Take ticket from machine.
- 2) Get the stamped Parking Discount Coupon in your program packet from INFOLINK at the registration.
- 3) When leaving, present both the stamped coupon and the parking deck ticket to the staff in the parking deck office (by the main entrance) and pay the discount rate (\$.50/hour).
- 4) If you run into a situation with using the coupon, please call the Crescent Deck at 973.744.6096 and ask to speak to Wycliffe, the manager of the facility. He will be able to assist.

In case the Crescent Parking Deck is full, other available parking lots are (no discount available):

- (1) directly across the street (the Plymouth Lot), and
- (2) one block closer to Bloomfield Ave. (the South Fullerton Lot)

### **By Train:**

The Library is approx. ½ mile from either the Bay Street or Walnut Street stations on NJ Transit's Montclair Branch [ [www.njtransit.com](http://www.njtransit.com) ]. If no taxicabs are standing at the station, call:

### **By Bus from New York (Port Authority Bus Terminal):**

DeCamp's #33 line (to West Caldwell) and #66 line (to West Orange) both run through Montclair.

The # 33 stops at Montclair Center (Bloomfield Ave., Glenridge Ave. and Fullerton.) Cross Bloomfield Ave. and walk two blocks south on South Fullerton to the library.

The # 66 stops at the corner of Church and Park Sts. (one stop after the YMCA on Park St.) Walk one block east on Church St, then 2 blocks south on S. Fullerton Ave. to the Library.

### **By Bus within New Jersey:**

NJ Transit Bus lines # 11, 28, 29 and 34 all serve Montclair Center (or Montclair: Bloomfield Ave. at Park St., one block west.) [www.njtransit.com](http://www.njtransit.com) . See walking directions as above.
