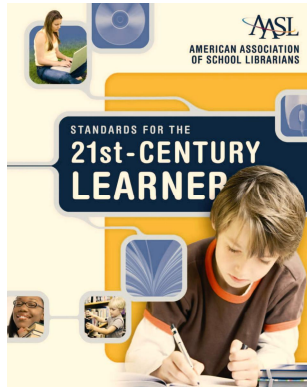

Hilda Weisburg retired on July 1, 2004 as library media specialist having worked at Morristown High School in Morristown, NJ and Sayreville elementary schools and its War Memorial High School. She teaches an online graduate courses at William Paterson University and had taught at Rutgers University. A past president of NJASL (when it was EMAnj), she is the association's delegate to AASL's Affiliate Assembly to which she has served as chair and Region II Director.

Currently, she is on the ALA Literacy Committee and the ALA/CBC (Children's Book Council) Joint Committee.
