

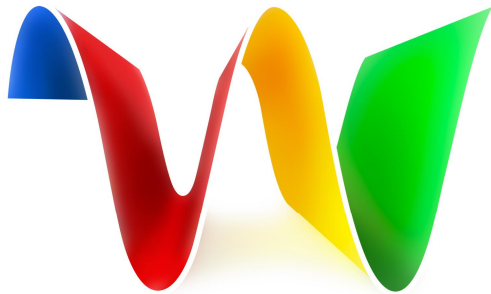

Have you ever wondered what email would look like if it were invented now, instead of 40 years ago?

Bob Keith, Technologist at the New Jersey State Library will take you on a tour of Google Wave with a live demonstration of what it can do.
